## Hoopeston Area Lady Cornjerkers fall to G-RF, Schlarman, A-P in basketball action

It's been a rough week for the Lady Cornjerkers, as they fell to Georgetown-Ridge Farm and Schlarman as visitors and to Armstrong-Potomac at home.

Georgetown-Ridge Farm managed to squeak by the Cornjerkers, 45-43 on Thursday. Tori Smock led scorers with 14, followed by Aly Zarate and Haley Dixon with eight.

Doris Varela led rebs with 10, with Dixon snagging six. Zarate had four assists and Karena Colunga had three. Colunga also contributed three steals with Dixon and Kylee Warner each with two.

On Saturday, Dixon led with 11 and Olivia Huls had seven towards the total 28 points against Schlarman's 54. Varela, Smock and Kylee Warner each had five rebounds for the night, while Zarate and Huls each had an assist.; Zarate led with five steals, and Warner and Huls each had two; while Rylee Waymouth had two blocks.

On Monday, the ladies came in the first quarter ready to defeat home court on Senior Night, but fell 58-44 to Armstrong-Potomac.

Senior Shelby Holzinger, sidelined with an ACL tear, cheered and coached up her team from the sidelines while fellow seniors Colunga, Smock and Carissa Vaughn took to the floor.

The girls started out hot, with Smock making a quick layup and Colunga hitting a three, said Coach Clinton Mathewson. After one quarter, the Lady Cornjerkers led 8-7. HAHS led for most of the next quarter until Armstrong's Megan Zindars hit two threes, leading to a 13-4 end of the quarter.

HA fought back outscoring AP 12-11 in the third, and got the score as close as four before AP got some space on free throws.

### HA men trounce Schlarman

Hoopeston Area took advantage of their home court to defeat Schlarman, 82-69.

The Cornjerkers were up 60-41 after three and extended their lead in the fourth until a late rally by the Hilltoppers cut it to 12 with under a minute.

Mason Layden led Cornjerker scoring with 22, followed by Daniel Lawson with 20, Trey Leyden with 14, Brennan Crose with 13 and Bryce Leigh with 11. David Cornelius added two to the total.

Crose also had 12 assists for the night.

The win brings the team's record to 12-8. They were scheduled to play Oakwood Tuesday night at home.
