Social Security Administration announces expedited disability screenings for veterans

Carolyn W. Colvin, Acting Commissioner of Social Security, announced the launch of a new disability process to expedite disability claims filed by veterans with a Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) disability compensation rating of 100% Permanent & Total (P&T).

Under the new process, Social Security will treat these applications as high priority and issue expedited decisions, similar to the way the agency currently handles disability claims from Wounded Warriors.
