Hoopeston Area Soccer, Chicago Fire to offer kids' clinics

Hoopeston Area Soccer and Chicago Fire's "Soccer in the Community" are teaming up to provide a soccer camp for local youngsters.

The camp will be held July 7-11 at Hoopeston Soccer Fields on South Sixth Ave., and is open to young people ages three through high school.

Recreational camp will be held for those ages three to 14, focusing on ball familiarity, dribbling and turning, passing and control and defending and attacking.

Camp for three- and four-year-olds will be held from 9-9:45 a.m. on camp days and will cost \$50 for

the session.

Five- and six-year-olds will have camp from 10-11:30 a.m. for a cost of \$85. Camp for those ages seven to 14 will be from 9 a.m.-noon with a \$100 fee.

High school students will have competitive camp from 9 a.m.-noon at a cost of \$110. Camp will focus on running with the ball, dribbling and turning, maintaining possession and finishing.

Cancer Society seeks volunteers to transport area patients

Getting to and from medical treatments is one of the greatest concerns cancer patients face during treatment. To ensure patients get to those much-needed treatments, the American Cancer Society provides free rides through its Road To Recovery® program.

The Society is currently looking for volunteer drivers in Vermilion County so that all patients have transportation when they need it. An estimated 66,000 Illinois residents will learn that they have cancer this year; however getting to their scheduled

treatment may be a challenge.

"One cancer patient requiring radiation therapy could need anywhere from 20 to 30 trips to treatment in six weeks," said Claire Sharp, Mission Delivery Specialist for the American Cancer Society. "A patient receiving chemotherapy might report for treatment weekly for up to a year. In many cases, a patient is driven to hospitals or clinics by relatives or friends, but even these patients must occasionally seek alternative transportation. That's where the Road To Recovery program comes in."

"The program not only helps patients, but is also rewarding for the volunteer. Several of our drivers have volunteered for a number of years," Sharp added.
