V-MEG tip leads to arrest of murder suspect in Watseka

A tip from Vermilion Metropolitan Enforcement Group led to the arrest in Watseka of a man wanted in Texas for capital murder. Gerardo Durant, 28, was arrested on unrelated crimes after police executed a search warrant at approximately 5:30 p.m. Monday on a home in the 400 block of North Fourth St. in Watseka. Police said Durant initially lied about who he was. When he gave them his name, a computer check revealed the warrant from Hidalgo County, Texas. According to published reports, cash, narcotics and

a weapon were found in the home where Durant was located. He was arrested on preliminary charges of unlawful use of a weapon by a felon, possession of cannabis and possession of drug paraphernalia. Police also seized \$4,255 in cash. The Watseka Enforcement Team, Iroquois County Sheriff's Police and V-Meg agents were involved in the arrest.

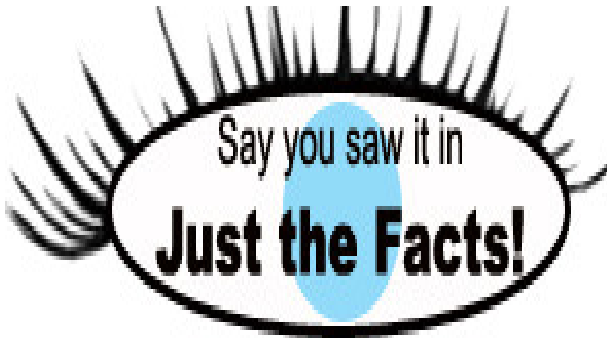
