



Right now our General Assembly is in what we refer

to as the legislative spring break, but for most Senators and Representatives, this doesn't mean a vacation. Right now we are working our way through our districts hosting town halls and meeting residents to talk about the

biggest issues facing our state.

This is an important part of the legislative process, because once we head back to Springfield, it will be "full speed ahead" working on the biggest issues facing our state.

Our biggest challenge will likely be to craft a budget that is both balance and maintains important core state services.

I have also been chosen by an alliance of educators to lead an effort to replace our out-of-date school funding formula with an evidence based model. We will also likely tackle such major subjects as workers comp re-
