# County board chair lays out plan to Hoopeston Council

Vermilion County Board Chairman Mike Marron visited Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting to talk about his vision for the county and to seek input from Hoopeston people.

Marron, who was accompanied by his vice-chair, Bill Wright, and District 1 member Darren Duncan, said he has been "making the rounds, opening the lines of communication," between himself and communities in the county.

Since being named chairman following Gary Weinard's resignation from the post last year, Marron has developed a four-point plan addressing:

County finances - Marron said it is important to look at finances from a strategic standpoint and "operate in an efficient manner for the taxpayers. One area he thinks will help curb costs in the long run is investing in new financial software. The existing system, he said, is from the 1980s.




