## For organizer, Cornathlon triathlon a fun family affair

"Ahh, it's over."

Scott Hudson breathed a sign of relief as Cornathlon, a triathlon to raise money for Hoopeston Area Sports Boosters, drew to a close.

Hudson, who with Phil Hollen, organized Saturday's inaugural event, admitted he didn't sleep much Friday night, both because of worry about how smoothly the event would go, but also because he wondered how his team would do.

As Hudson gave swimmers their instructions at the start of Cornathlon, his wife, Kristie, was waiting for her turn in the pool. When she finished the 150 meter swim, Hudson hopped on his bike for the 12,5 mile ride. Returning to overseeing the event, he passed the running component to his 12-year-old son, Sam.

The family finished with a total 1:22:42 for their efforts. Hudson was pleased with their performance and the event as a whole. "It was awesome," he said. "It sounds corny but I almost got teary-eyed when they finished." A total 93 people participated in the maiden event, which boasted 20 teams.

## **Cornathlon** continued from other side

Pleased with what had just ended, Hudson was already talking about changes for next year's Cornathlon, which is set for July 2, 2016.

First, he hopes to have electronic timing for the swimming leg. At a minimum, that will cost \$1,500, so Hudson hopes to find three major sponsors to offset that cost.

He would also like to see more kids participate and hopes to have a larger group of volunteers next year.

Two other changes are related to the area's rail system. Five participants were stopped by a train while cyclists found the tracks at Cheneyville quite jarring. To eliminate those problems, the turnaround point for cycling will be the road north of Conservation Club Road, and in town, the course will be redesigned to avoid athletes having to cool their heels for passing trains.
