In other business, the council:

• Heard from Alderman Randy Carter about a new truck for the street and alley department. A bid is in hand but officials are waiting for the state bid cost to be announced on September 28. If that bid is lower, Carter sought approval for Mayor Bill Crusinberry to sign a contract for a 2015-16 4500 series chassis with a 9' dump bed.
