They rolled through the streets of Hoopeston Saturday afternoon like conquering heroes.

Hoopeston Area Middle School's baseball team was escorted around the city by a police car and fire truck, followed by vehicles containing friends and family members, before returning to the middle school, after the team won its sectional competition.

Hoopeston Area defeated Grant Park, 10-2, in seven

innings, Saturday to earn the back-to-back sectional crown at Gibson City-Melvin Sibley Middle School in Gibson City.

The victory brings the team to 17-1 on the season as it prepares for back-to-back appearances at state finals.

The Cornjerkers will take on Springfield Blessed Sacrament (16-3) at 2:30 p.m. October 2 at Eastside Center in East Peoria.
