HA agrees to one-year extension of Tri-Party Agreement

Hoopeston Area officials unanimously approved a one-year extension of the Tri-Party Deactivation Agreement Thursday night.

The agreement, among Hoopeston Area, Rossville-Alvin and Bismarck-Henning, covers issues related to students of the deactivated Rossville-Alvin High School, who now may choose to attend either of the other high schools.

R-A eighth graders will visit the middle school February 24 and their parents will visit that evening, prior to choosing which high school their children will attend.

Bismarck-Henning and Rossville-Alvin are currently in talks to form a cooperative high school.

In other business, the board:

- Held a public hearing prior to the regular meeting, on issuing Working Cash Fund bonds. The board plans to vote on the matter at its February 18 meeting.
- Heard from Supt. Hank Hornbeck that parents should make sure students are dressed warmly in cold weather and have a plan with their children in case of weatherrelated early dismissals.
- Discussed the ag auction that will be held January 30 at Hoopeston American Legion.
