It's amazing what havoc 40 mile per hour winds and 4 or so inches of snow can wreak.

Hoopeston awakened to rain showers that then turned to snow and sleet, before changing to all snow.

Area schools opted to close before the snow started, believing the blizzard warning issued Tuesday night that became effective at 6 a.m. Wednesday. The warning was set to expire at 9 p.m. Wednesday.

Blizzard continued from other side

At 2:30 p.m. Wednesday, interstates 72, 74 and 57 in central Illinois were all listed as snow covered. Illinois State Police issued a travel advisory, asking motorists to refrain from driving unless it was absolutely necessary.

In Hoopeston, with school closed and other services curtailed by the weather, many drivers just stayed home. A snow route emergency was called early in the day, necessitating owners move cars from streets designated as snow routes throughout the city.

Power was affected, too, with flickering lights and some outages reported. While inconvenient, the experience was worse for Ameren customers south and west of Hoopeston, many of whom were without power for most of the day. Ameren reported at 1:30 that more than 1,600 county residents were without power. That number was 7,200 in Douglas County.

Ameren reported nearly 100 broken or leaning poles as the storm continued. More than 500 workers and contractors responded, with additional crews coming from Wisconsin, Indiana, Michigan and Kansas.
