## Traffic stop Thursday morning nets two Springfield men wanted on felony warrants

Police arrested two Springfield men after a traffic stop at 6:17 a.m. Thursday at Rtes. 1 and 9.

Michael M. Lipscomb, 22, was wanted on a Sangamon County felony warrant for aggravated discharge of a firearm. He was also charged with no valid license and improper parking/intersection.

Lipscomb was taken to the Public Safety Building in Danville to await extradition in lieu of \$50,000 cash bond.

Also arrested was Jeremy S. Jones, 22, wanted on an Illinois Department of Corrections felony warrant for violation of parole/no bond. He was held of IDOC extradition.
