Tomahawk throw at deputy results in charges for Milford man

A rural Milford man is being held on \$500,000 after being charged with battering a peace officer and criminal sexual assault and abuse charges.

Iroquois County Sheriff's deputies went to a home at 1131 N 1800 East Road in rural Milford at 1:45 p.m. Friday to arrest Kevin D. Funk, 29. He was to be arrested on a charge of predatory sexual assault of a child, following an investigation.

As he and deputies talked, Funk allegedly armed himself with a tomahawk and threw it at a deputy, who raised his left arm to protect his head. The tomahawk struck the deputy.

More deputies arrived at the scene and Funk was taken into custody.

The injured deputy was taken to Iroquois Memorial Hospital, Watseka, and treated for a fractured left arm and dislocated finger. He received several stitches to close a laceration.

Funk was arraigned Monday in Iroquois County Circuit Court on three counts each of predatory criminal sexual assault and aggravated criminal sexual abuse and one count each of aggravated battery to a peace officer and attempted murder and was being held in lieu of \$50,000 cash bond.

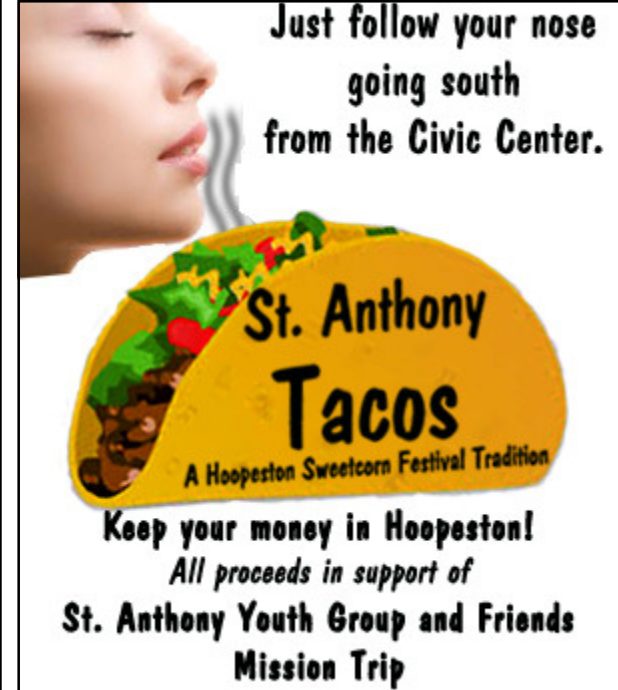

A Hoopeston store has seen a surge in cell phone sales, making it Consumer Cellular's top seller in the district.

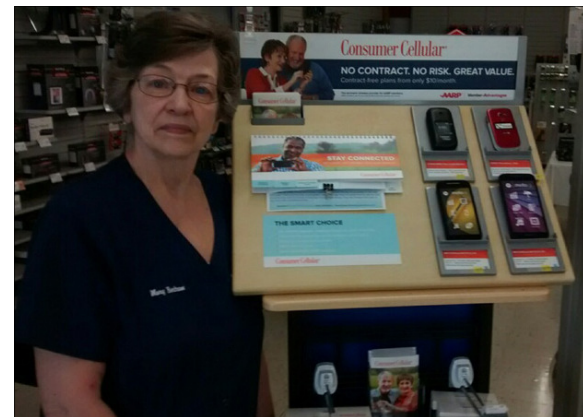
