DACC Hoopeston seeks volunteers for new tutoring program

A new tutoring program planned for the DACC Higher Learning Center - Hoopeston is seeking volunteers and participants.

Karla Coon, Higher Learning Center director, and Kay Knapp, who will oversee the tutoring program, were at Thursday evening's Hoopeston Area School Board meeting to discuss the project.

Free one-on-one tutoring will be available to learners from third grade to adult, Coon said. Goals include improving academic performance, developing more effective study habits, building positive relationships, providing resources for parents to support their children academically and encourage students in lifetime educational pursuits.

Tutors, who will come from the community and may include honors high school students, will complete an application, including when they are available and what subjects they want to tutor and must have a background check.

Program staff will match tutors to participants and an introductory meeting will be held. A contract will be established, including expectations, schedule and duration of the tutoring.

Students will be responsible for bringing all necessary materials for study, including textbooks and assignments. The HLC computer lab will be available unless occupied by a DACC class.

Because the HLC has flexible hours, tutoring sessions can be held at almost any time determined by the tutor and participant, Coon said.

One resource Coon would like to tap into to for help training tutors is retired teachers, who "may not want to tutor a student but they will tutor a tutor."

The new program will not be in competition with existing ones, such as that offered by the Hoopeston Multi Agency and one being started by First Church of God. Marketing materials for the new program will also include information on the other tutoring services, she said.

Anyone interested in being a volunteer tutor may call the Higher Learning Center, (217) 283-4170.

In related discussion, Coon reported that the dual enrollment program, which allows Hoopeston Area High School students to also take DACC classes, is doing well. While DACC enrollment is down a little, HLC numbers are up a bit, she said.

In other business, the board approved the administrative salary compensation report, setting superintendent and principal salaries for this fiscal year.

According to the report, Supt. Hank Hornbeck will end his tenure at Hoopeston Area with a base salary of \$138,063.25, up from 129,675.82 last year. On top of that, he will receive \$13,654.61 towards his retirement and \$8,172 in the board-paid portion of health insurance.

Sam Fanning, longtime Milford High School football coach dies

Sam Fanning, 67, of Milford, longtime Milford School District teacher, athletic director and coach, died Thursday, Sept. 15, 2016 at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee.

Mr. Fanning coached Bearcats football from 1979-1996 and served as athletic director from 1984-2006. His coaching career included seven playoff appearances, five conference championships and a 100-win career. In 2001, he won Class A Outstanding Athletic Director of the Year.

Mr. Fanning is survived by his wife, Terri,; daughters Nichole (Berto) Leone of Peoria and Jacqueline (Josh) Meister, both of Peoria; two grandchildren; and one sister.

He was cremated. Visitation was from noon until the 3 p.m. memorial service Sunday at Sam Fanning Stadium at Milford High School.
