Library to provide free pumpkins for decorating contest

Hoopeston Public Library is getting ready to celebrate the Halloween season with a free pumpkin decorating contest in October – and the library will even provide the pumpkins.

The contest is open to local residents from age five through adult. There will be awards for age groups from 5-7, 8-11, 12-15 and 16-adult, plus a special "Family" category, for at least one adult and one child working together. There will also be categories for different types of decorating: Painted, Carved or Other.

Free pumpkins are being provided (while supplies last) by library staff member Terri Hambleton and her husband, Mel. Patrons may register and "check out" their free pumpkin at the library from Oct. 5-7 during regular hours. Decorated pumpkins should be returned between 10 a.m., Thursday, Oct. 13 and 12 noon, Friday, Oct. 14.

Participants are also welcome to provide their own pumpkins and they can register those when they drop off their entry, no later than noon on Oct. 14.

Library director Tricia Freeland said library staff hope this contest will be reminiscent of the Pumpkin Family Reunion festivals which were held in downtown Hoopeston in the 1980s and 1990s.

Watch for SMV's this fall

We've all seen the bright orange & red triangle on the back of tractors, construction equipment, even horse buggies. But what is it?

That reflective orange and red triangle is called a slow moving vehicle emblem (SMV emblem). The center orange triangle is designed to be brightly visible during the day, with the reflective red stripes showing up at night.

Illinois law requires an SMV emblem be visible at all times to the rear of various vehicles using public roads:

- •implements of husbandry (farm equipment)
- •animal-drawn vehicles

- •special mobile equipment
- •neighborhood vehicles (where permitted some communities require SMVs on golf carts)

The SMV requirement is not contingent on the actual speed of the vehicle. But it is a warning that the vehicle it's on is traveling slower than the rest of traffic, so caution needs to be used.

When you approach any vehicle displaying a SMV emblem, it's a good idea to take your foot off the accelerator immediately and be prepared to slow down:

- A car traveling 55 mph that sees a tractor traveling 15 mph will close a 400 foot gap between the two in just seven seconds!
- By comparison, it takes 27 seconds for that same 55 mph car to close the same 400' gap with a car traveling 45 mph.

That's why it's important to not misuse a SMV emblem.

Some people like to put them on their mailboxes or driveway posts, because they're bright and easy to see. But they are designed to be seen on slow moving equipment, not gates and mailboxes.

In Illinois, it is illegal to use a SMV for any use other than on slow moving vehicles. It reduces the effectiveness of the symbol as a warning for the slow equipment. And it is punishable by a \$75 fine for each sign that is misused.

You also need to be cautious when you approach equipment on the roads. When passing farm equipment on the left, make sure that the farm driver is not slowing down to turn left into a field, township road

or farm driveway.

Some newer farm equipment has turn signals. If you see two flashing lights, then one light is steady while the other continues to flash, that is the tractor's turn signal.

Farmers need to do their part to make sure they have the proper reflective markings on their equipment. And motorists need to be cautious on the roads this fall (and always), and be aware of the farm equipment using the roads.
