



## Students to converge on DACC for WYSE academic challenge

Danville Area Community College will host the 39th annual Academic Challenge competition, Tuesday, Feb. 14 in the Mary Miller Gymnasium. Ten area school districts, represented by about 150 students, are expected to send participants from their junior and senior classes to this year's competition.

Each school is required to have at least six team members, but most send 14 or more participants. The competition is open to all classes, but mainly consists of juniors and seniors.

The Academic Challenge is a battery of tests created by the Worldwide Youth in Science and Engineering Society (WYSE). Participants are tested in seven academic areas including mathematics, physics, chemistry, biology, English, engineering graphics, and computer science.

Between arrival at 9 a.m. and lunch at 11:30 a.m., students receive a brief orientation and take two 40-minute tests. Teams must have at least two students test in each of the three required areas of English,

math, and chemistry and two students in at least two of the other four areas to qualify for team awards.

DACC staff and faculty from the Science and Math Division meet with team coaches during the testing periods to update them on future changes to the test program and receive feedback on the competition.

Following the testing periods, students are treated to a pizza lunch while test scores are finalized. DACC provides entertainment, including math and science games while participants await the results.

Award presentations are at approximately 12:45 p.m. Individual medallions are awarded for those placing first through third place over all the divisions in each testing area.

Winners of the regional competition continue on to the sectionals at Eastern Illinois University on March 9, and then may advance to the State Finals at the University of Illinois.

This year the challenge will also include a contest which is designed to introduce local students to careers.
