Hoopeston gives TIF funds to HA all-weather track project

Hoopeston officials have agreed to help fund a project that will have Hoopeston Area students running in circles.

At Tuesday's meeting, Hoopeston City Council approved giving \$50,000 of tax increment financing (TIF) funds to Hoopeston Area schools for its allweather track project.

Each year, Hoopeston gives TIF funds to the school district for special projects - usually infrastructure that meet TIF criteria.

Ald. Bill Goodwine, finance committee chairman. has said the school is most impacted by the city's TIF program and the annual payment helps offset some of what the district does not get in tax revenue because of the TIF.

Most years, the payment is \$35,000 to \$40,000, but this year, the school district asked for \$50,000, along with a commitment from the council as a "representation of the city's intent" to support the project over a five-year span, Goodwine said. The district can then leverage that intent into more donations for the project.

Hoopeston Area has asked for \$50,000 payments for three years, followed by a \$35,000 payment in year 4 and a \$45,000 payment in year 5, bringing the city's contribution to \$230,000.

Information on the project's total costs were not

In unrelated business, the council unanimously approved a change in the ownership of Hoopeston's cable franchise.

Michael A. Lopez Jr., director of operations for Phoenix, AZ-based Cable One, was at the meeting to talk about the company's purchase of NewWave Communications and how it will affect Hoopeston.

Lopez said Cable One has no plans to change personnel in the Westville office, which oversees Hoopeston. There are also no immediate plans to change offerings, packages or prices.

Cable One plans to participate in the communities it serves by volunteering to raise money or supporting local groups, Lopez said.

According to printed reports Cable One purchased NewWave, which is headquartered in Sikeston, Mo., for \$735 million. The sale, which Lopez said is expected to be finalized in mid-May, will add 214,000 subscribers to its network of video, residential broadband and residential phone customers.
