City woman charged after allegedly striking man with car

A 38-year-old Hoopeston woman was being held in at the Public Safety Building in Danville after allegedly running over an unidentified man during a domestic dispute.

Monica L. Zamora was arrested at 11:51 a.m. Wednesday on preliminary charges of aggravated domestic battery with great bodily harm and aggravated battery with great bodily harm after police were called to the 800 block of South Fourth St. for a man lying in the street with injuries.

At the same time as that call, police said a hysterical woman called to say she hit a man with her car due to a

domestic issue going on.

The 40-year-old man was taken to Carle Foundation Hospital for trauma issues sustained in the accident. A condition report on him was not available at press time.

Zamora was taken to Carle Hoopeston, where she was treated and released to police. She was then taken to the Public Safety Building in Danville to await arraignment.
