Joel Bird named District 1 rep to Vermilion County Board

Northern Vermilion County has its full slate of representatives on the Vermilion County Board.

Joel Bird was selected by the Vermilion County Republican Central Committee on April 29 to be the newest District 1 representative and was sworn in at Tuesday night's county board meeting.

Bird replaces Darren Duncan, of Rossville, was appointed in 2014, replacing Gary Weinard, who retired. Duncan ran last November and won a four-year term but on March 11, he was selected to be Vermilion County treasurer. He began his new duties April 3.

Bird said he had thought about running for office, but didn't take the step. As a committeeman, Bird said he was at a meeting about Duncan being named treasurer when he was approached by three or four other committeemen, who encouraged him to apply for the seat, and a couple more outside politics, also encouraged him.

Bird said he plans to "jump in with both feet and see what's going on in the county," but said he has no agenda.

While a representative, Duncan often attended Hoopeston City Council meetings, both to see what was going on in the city and to keep residents up-to-date on county business.

That's a tradition Bird is likely to continue because - as chief of the Hoopeston Fire Department - he already attends most meetings.

Bird, 40, has been on the department for 15 years and was named chief in 2014.

A lifelong Hoopeston resident, Bird works for Champaign Danville Grain Inspection, where inspects railroad cars at local elevators, including Hoopeston. He has been with the company for 20 years.


