Services have been set for a 12-year-old Cissna Park boy who died from injuries sustained in a car accident last week.

Visitation for Jacob D. Rose will be 9-11 a.m. Thursday at Creekside Prairie, 510 A. Prairie Lane, Cissna Park, Funeral will follow at 11 a.m. at Creekside Prairie. Burial will be in Cissna Park Cemetery.

He is survived by his mother,

Jacob was pronounced dead at 12:41 p.m. July 23 at Carle Foundation Hospital, following a one-vehicle accident on County Road 600 North, about a half mile east of County Road 1300 East in Iroquois County.

driven by his mother, Elisabeth A. Bretveld, 37, of Cissna Park. Her vehicle cleft the road and entered a ditch on the

north of the road. The vehicle went about 150 feet through the ditch before it struck a drainage ditch embankment head-on.
