## Midnight practice builds excitement for Cornjerker football

First-year coach Trey Stille wants not only his players to be excited about this year's Cornjerker team, but the communities involved in the co-op program.

At 12:01 a.m. Saturday, the first day high school teams could practice in full pads, Stille put his players through their paces. "We want to show that we are ready to be full-go, as soon as we can legally be full-go," Stille said of the unusual practice session.

Announcement of the practice caused confusion, causing Stille to take to social media to explain IHSA practice rules, then chastised naysayers, writing "I understand that this may seem like an UNCOMMON thing to do but I am of the opinion that WINNING is UNCOMMON. Doing the same thing all the time, and resisting positive change, has NEVER brought about progress. Progressing is exactly what we are doing at HASAAP Football, and we invite you to join us in our efforts to BE THE CHANGE that we wish to see in our football program, schools, communities, and in our world." he wrote.



A goodly number of parents and Cornjerker fans stayed off sleep to watch the team in their first full practice.

Stille, who last year was an assistant coach to the cooperative team of Hoopeston Area, Schlarman Academy and Armstrong Potomac, will see if the enthusiasm for the early practice will carry through the season.

the Lorraine.

An EIEC board member suggested the Lorraine foundation for the electric co-op's charitable giving, said Alex Houmes of the Save the Lorraine Foundation.

EIEC is also a business partner with CoBank, based outside of Denver, Colo.

CoBank provides loans, leases, export financing and other financial services to agribusinesses and rural power, water and communications providers in all 50 states.

One of CoBank's corporate giving programs, Sharing Success, is a \$3 million charitable fund that matches contributions from CoBank's cooperative and other eligible customers to nonprofit organizations of their choice.

EIEC donated \$2,000 to HVAC improvements at the theater, which CoBank matched.

The money was used to replace the theater's old "swamp cooler," an evaporative cooling system, with a modern system, Houmes said.
