Hoopeston Area school board approves 6.55 acre land purchase

The grounds of Hoopeston Area school district will soon be a little bigger after action taken at a special board meeting Tuesday evening.

Following an executive session, the board approved purchasing 6.55 acres just west of the high school for \$112,000, said Supt. Suzzette Hesser.

The purchase was approved in a 6-0 vote, with board

President Mark Schaumburg absent.

The school's FFA program currently rents the ground for use.

Hesser said the board recently became interested in purchasing the property to be prepared for the long-term future needs of the district. There was no discussion of specific projects, she said.


