Louise had been hired to teach in the rural one room school house and met Felix when she boarded at Felix's mother's home.

They moved from Kentucky to rural Rossville, Ill., in 1944 where Louise continued teaching at the Waveland School located northeast of Rossville until its closing in 1946 and Felix began to deliver fuel oil to the local farm area. A short time later the couple began to farm west of

Rossville.

The couple have two children, a daughter Brenda (Gary) Weinard and a son, Terry (Barbara) Morgan all of Hoopeston. They also have been blessed with five grandchildren, 12 great-grandchildren and three great-great-grandchildren.

The couple is members of the Rossville Church of Christ and continues to reside west of Rossville where they remain healthy and active.
