**Trey Houmes runs the course to state cross country meet**

Trey Houmes is kicking it during his last year as a member of the Hoopeston Area cross country team. Houmes led the Cornjerker cross country team, coming in first at the county meet on October 17 and again at the Bishop McNamara regionals on October 21, finishing with a time of 15:54. Saturday, Houmes placed third at the Lisle Sectional in Community Park, finishing in 16:04 on "one of the toughest courses in the state," said head coach Erika Seidel, adding adverse conditions included cold, wind and snow/sleet on and off during the meet. Houmes was the second individual qualifier for the state meet from the sectional. The top seven individuals

and top five teams advance to the state meet, which will be held this Saturday at Detweiller Park in Peoria. Not only did he excel at cross country, but Houmes was also named to the all-county and all-conference teams in soccer. "He was doing double duty the entire season," Seidel said. "Most days, he had two practices and/or games and meets."

Team wise, the Cornjerkers came in second at both conference, with 48 points, and county, with 50. At conference, Dawson Grissom game in 10th, followed by Joe Cropper 11th, Eli Wisdom 14th; Michael Helmuth 16th, Adam Dixon 17th, and Clay Goodrum, 20th.
