Beautification director makes pitch for continued membership

Brenda Adams, executive director of Keep Vermilion County Beautiful, is making her way around the county, introducing herself to officials and making the case for continued KVCB membership. Tuesday evening, she made her pitch to the Hoopeston City Council.

For a minimum of \$150, the city can continue to be a part of KVCB, said Adams, now in her third year as KVCB head. The amount allows Hoopeston to send a representative to the group's board meetings and also apply for beautification grants of up to \$1,000 each. "You're getting your money back many times over," if selected for a grant, Adams said.

In recent years, Hoopeston bumped up its donation to the organization to \$250, according to records. Mayor Bill Crusinberry said both the city and school district have received KVCB grants.

Heard from Ald. Ryan Anderson that leaf cleanup is ongoing. Residents are asked to leave piles of leaves at curbside but not in the gutter, where they can be swept into storm drains.

Ryan also made a motion, seconded by Ald. Bill Goodwine, that the city spend not more than \$4,375 resurfacing the parking lot at city hall. The measure passed 5-0, with Alex Houmes, Carl Ankenbrand and Chad Yaden absent.
