Hoopeston man, Wellington woman die in head-on collision

Two local people are dead following a head-on crash at 6:21 p.m. Wednesday on Route 1 at County Road 3870.

The driver of the first vehicle has been identified as 52-year-old Warren W. Harms, of Hoopeston, according to Vermilion County Coroner Jane McFadden.

Mr. Harms was pronounced dead at the scene.

Denise L. Ried, 59, of Wellington, was identified as the driver of the second vehicle, according to Duane Northrup, Champaign County coroner.

Mrs. Ried was airlifted from the scene to Carle Foundation Hospital, Urbana, where she was pro-

nounced dead at 8:16 p.m.

According to information released last night by State Trooper Tracy Lillard, Mr. Harms was northbound in a pickup truck. For an unknown reason, he crossed the center line, striking Mrs. Ried's southbound minivan.

Reports did not indicate passengers in either vehicle.

Hoopeston Fire Rescue responded to the accident which is still under investigation by Illinois State Police and the Champaign and Vermilion county coroner's offices.
