# Cornjerker Ezra Elliott grapples way to third in state at 126

Hoopeston Area junior Ezra Elliott came home from the weekend's state wrestling finals with third place hon-

Elliott (34-2) started his 1A series with a 13-2 major decision over senior Garrett Lashuay (43-5) of Oakwood.

Next Elliott was pitted against Rockridge High School sophomore Dallas Krueger (45-5). The Cornjerker got his second win in a 6-1 decision.

The win set up Elliott's final match, against Althoff Catholic senior Chase Bittle (50-4) who defeated Elliott

in a 4-2 decision to move on to the title match. There, Bittle lost Noah Villarreal (44-3). The Aurora Christian sophomore defeated Bittle in a 9-7 overtime decision.

In the 182 lb. class, HA senior Eliseo Zamora (51-2) lost to Zac Braunagel (51-2), a senior at Althoff Catholic, by technical fall at 1:49. Zamora won his next match in a 7-5 decision against Julian James (32-17), a junior at Aurora Christian.

Zamora's final match was a 9-5 decision loss to Brian Caves (43-9), a freshman at Riverdale High School.


