75th National Sweetcorn Festival blends old favs, new acts

Old and new will combine to provide family fun during the 75th National Sweetcorn Festival this weekend.

Running Thursday evening through Monday evening at McFerren Park, the festival has something to offer for all ages.

After a hiatus, bingo returns to the festival this year, from 6-9 p.m. Thursday in the Jaycee Shelter. For those who like things that go vroom, motocross will be held Friday in the annex, followed on Sunday by a demo derby.

Combining accordion playing and balloon art, Polka Pop Balloon Stop will offer music and art to festival goers throughout the weekend.

For youngsters, bracelet ride specials will be held each day. Hoopeston Area FFA will have a petting zoo, and kids can shine at the children's fishing derby Saturday and pie eating contest Sunday.

Others who want to take home a prize may enter the hula hoop, bubble gum bubble blowing or ponytail contests or the annual car show.

Marking its 10th anniversary this year, the Cream of the Crop Pretty Baby Contest will take place during Monday. Registration will begin at 9 a.m. and the contest at 10 a.m. Trophies and ribbons will be awarded age categories 0-6 months, 7-12 months, 13-18 months, 19-24 months, and 25-36 months. An overall winner will also be named. Attire is the contestant's choice.

Entry fee is \$5, with proceeds benefitting the Hoopeston Chapter of Blessings in a Backpack, a weekend food program for students.

The Bill Orr Memorial 5K and Little Corn Eaters Run will kick off at 8 and 8:45 a.m. respectively, from Sculpt Fitness, 210 S. Market.

This year's National Sweetheart Pageant has a field of 23 girls from across the country. Preliminaries will begin at 6:30 p.m. Saturday, wrapping up Sunday with finals at 6:30 and the post-pageant reception at 9 p.m., all in the McFerren Park Civic Center.

Chris Lane is this year's featured artist at the festival, performing at 6:30 p.m. Saturday in the annex. Other musical acts will be featured at various areas of the park.
