Lorraine Foundation to raise funds to stabilize old city hall

The Lorraine Foundation will roll out a new fundraiser this weekend in an effort to raise money to save another historic downtown building.

The "History Saving Sale" will offer a variety of donated items - mostly antique - including furniture, décor and architectural salvage. Located at the Old City Hall, 229 S. Market, the sale's initial earnings are earmarked for roof and structural repairs on the Old City Hall. Going forward, proceeds will benefit the Lorraine Foundation's efforts to restore downtown Hoopeston.

The sale will be held Friday from noon-4 p.m. and Saturday through Monday from 10 a.m.-4 p.m. Those coming to the sale are asked to use the south entrance.

"We still do not have official plans for the Old City Hall other than securing it so that it may be preserved for future use," said foundation member Alex Houmes. "We're hoping this sale will provide the necessary funds to do that. People can also help out by donating antique/unique items to our sale."
