Obituaries

James L. Lloyd

Rev. Jim Lloyd, 78 of Willis, TX, passed away Saturday, September 1, 2018. He was born June 12, 1940 in Hoopeston, to Leon and Reva (Wallace) Lloyd.

Jim graduated in 1958 from Rossville High School, Rossville. In June 1960, he married Temple Donaldson. Together they began an amazing journey. In May of 1961, he graduated from Indiana College of Mortuary Science.

From 1967 - 1976, he owned and operated Lloyd Funeral Home in Delphi, Ind. In 1983, he and Temple went to Rhema Bible Training Center. After graduation in 1985, they spent a year in Chicago ministering to Eastern Indians and Gypsies. In the spring of 1986, they moved back to Rossville, and with friends founded New Bethel Fellowship which later became Morningstar Ministries. An Evangelist at heart, Jim spent 21 years pastoring the church and taking groups all over the country to street witness for the Lord he loved. That time also included trips to Russia and Bulgaria. In August 2007, Jim turned the church over to Dan Mikel who had been with him from the beginning. He and Temple moved to Houston, Tex. in December 2007, then in July of 2009 they moved to Lake Conroe in Willis, Tex., fulfilling a lifelong dream of living on a lake. For the last few years, he has found his true calling as a Hospice Chaplain, most recently with Encompass.

He is survived by his loving wife of 58 years, Temple; four children, James II of Willis TX, Taryn (Mark) Little of Willis, TX, Kristin (Tod) Hufford of Alvin, IL, and Scott of Chicago, IL; seven grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren; and numerous nieces, nephews and friends.

Preceding him in death were his parents, a brother Steve, and a great-granddaughter.

Memorial service will be held Monday, Sept. 10, 2018 at 6 p.m. at Morningstar Church, 201 N. Chicago, Rossville, IL 60963.
