### Crushing weight

Winds gusting to more than 40 miles per hour, sent a tree crashing into Amanda Kester's home Saturday in the 700 block of South Fifth St., tearing the porch roof from the house. No injuries were reported as the family had gone to see a movie in Danville, said Bryant Kester. Elm Street was closed in front of the house, in part because of downed utility lines. The street remained closed Sunday morning as people with chainsaws helped clear the debris. Strong gusts were experienced most of Saturday, causing trees to shed limbs or be toppled altogether. Significant damage was also done to playground equipment at McFerren Park. Winds also caused power blips and outages. According to Ameren's outage map, one customer east of Hoopeston was still without power at 10 p.m. Service was not expected to be restored until 11:30 p.m., according to the map.
