## Hoopeston man pleads guilty to drug-related charges, sentenced to nine years consecutive

A Hoopeston man was sentenced to a total of nine years in prison after pleading guilty on December 3 in two drug -related cases.

Jordan Carswell, 32, was sentenced to four years in the Illinois Department of Corrections after pleading guilty to one count of methamphetamine delivery, a Class 1 felony.

That charge stemmed from an incident on June 3, when a Vermilion County Sheriff's deputy responded to a report of a suspicious vehicle in the area of Artesian and South Vermilion in Danville.

A press release from Vermilion County State's Attorney Jacqueline Lacy said Carswell was asleep at the wheel, and when awakened, was searched and found to possess a two bags of methamphetamine, one with 3.6 grams and a second bag with 3.2 grams, as well as \$1,150 in cash.

The four-year sentence will be served consecutively to a five-year sentence after Carswell also pleaded guilty to bringing contraband into a penal institution - controlled substance, also a Class 1 felony.

That charge stemmed from activity in July and August,

when a VCSD investigator learned of a plan where Carswell's alleged girlfriend would send controlled substances to him while he was housed at the Vermilion County Jail on the previous matter.

According to the press release, the plan was uncovered by monitoring jail phone calls between the two, which indicated she would send letters to him with areas of dissolved methamphetamine on the paper.

On August 1, the jail intercepted a letter, which had a yellowish stain which tested positive for methamphetamine, according to the press release.

Carswell was already on probation for two meth cases
