Freshman Lexie Breymeyer led the Lady Cornjerkers to their first win in the Vermilion County Tournament Wednesday night.

The guard led Hoopeston Area scoring with 13 points, in a 46-16 victory over Georgetown-Ridge Farm.

Senior Shelby Symmonds added 11 to the total, with senior Ariel Reeves adding 10. Freshman Alisyn Watson scored 8 points while fellow freshman Emma Glotbach and senior Breanna Martin each added two.

Breymeyer and senior Shelby Symmonds tied for number of three-point shots at three each, with Reeves hitting one from the arc.

Georgetown had no three pointers and, at 13, nearly double the 7 fouls committed by the Lady Cornjerkers.

The ladies will play at 5 p.m. Friday, followed at 6:30 p.m. by the game for third place, pitting Salt Fork and Westville. The 8 p.m. battle for first place will feature Bismarck-Henning/Rossville-Alvin and Oakwood.
