

The motion offers three alternatives: dismis bandruptcy proceedings or shorten the debtor's exclusive period to file reorganization under Chapter 11 or convert the case from a Chapter 11 to a Chapter 7.

Pat O'Shaunessy of First Midwest said last week that the action is not unusual. "We're pursu

ing our legal rights and the normal course of remedy," he said.

The bank's action will have no effect on farmers or liquidation efforts by the state, he said.


