Hoopeston schools fare well at Watseka competition

Farmers may take clean, dry plastic agrichemical containers to the centers. All labels, booklets and foil seals must be removed from containers.

Ag officials will inspect all containers brought for recycling. Those not properly prepared will not be accepted.

The July 18 center will be from 1-5 p.m. at the Donovan Farmers Co-op in Donovan. July 29, the program will be from 8 a.m. to noon at Terra International. Inc., in Fisher.

Aug. 4, the center will be at the Sidell-Vermilion Service Company in Sidell, from 1-5 p.m., and On Aug. 5, it will be at Tri Central Co-op in Ashkum from 8 a.m. until noon.


