Treasurer announces March interest on county deposits

Herb Hales, Vermilion County treasurer, reported that for the month of March 1994, the county has \$17,179,779.29 invested in time deposits and U.S. Treasury bonds, earning between 3.1 and 9.1 percent interest.

County funds on hand in interest-bearing checking accounts total \$2,799,023.32 earning betweent 2.5 and 3.75 percent.

All money handled by the treasurer totals \$19,978,802.61.

Deposits of local interest include:Palmer American National Bank, Hoopeston branch, \$1 million; Rankin branch, \$100,000; Community Bank of Hoopeston, \$2,012,959.85; Hoopeston Household FSB, \$100,000; and First National Bank of Rossville, \$101,902.44.

Other deposits include: First Midwest Bank, \$3,848,695.49; Palmer American National Bank, total, \$3,373,985.16; main bank, \$2,073,985.16; Potomac branch, \$100,000; Tilton branch,

The local group hopes to make enough to pay for the work crew donation, a minimum of \$350. Each crew member is also charged \$125 for room and board. Crew leaders provide transportation. Each year, the number of participants increases, Goodner said, adding this year's "vacation" will be spent in Chavies, Ky.

There are 14 service centers throughout the Appalachia area, Goodner said. Between five and 10 crews are at each service center each week of the program. Each crew is comprised of five to seven people. Last summer, more than 280 homes were repaired by 6,711 young volunteers.

One thing keeps bringing youngsters back to help with the project. "The people," one girl said. "They open their homes to strangers, but by the end of the week, we are friends, sharing our lives and our dreams.


