Local solid waste committee members praise proposal

Local members of the Vermilion County solid waste management committee believe the county's proposed solid waste plan is a good start.

Lowell Null. owner of M&N Pallet, and Rich Galloway of Illinois Landfills. Inc., both sit on the 23-member committee which drafted the plan.

"I think it's a start." said Null, who has been on the committee for about nine months.

Galloway called the plan the "least expensive because it has very minimal labor, very minimal trucking."

Both men said the recycling component of the plan is the highlight of the proposal. Under the plan, boxes will be located throughout the county for residents to drop off recylables. Educational programs on recycling are also planned.

Using drop-off boxes "is probably the most fea-

sible right now since there's no recycling center in the county," Null said, "A lot of stuff from our area was going to Champaign."

Galloway said he thinks the plan will work "but they have to have good drop-off sites. They have to be policed and not open to the public 24 hours a day."

Galloway said the plan will not affect Illinois Landfills' plan to operate a no-cost curbside recycling program in Hoopeston if their expansion request is approved.

County officials are seeking public input on the proposed solid waste plan.

A public comment hearing is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. this evening at room 213 of the courthouse annex.

A public hearing is set for September.
