Meeting held on Rossville Neighborhood Watch

ROSSVILLE—A meeting last week to establish a Neighborhood Watch program here drew fewer people than expected, but village officials hope more interest can be generated.

Only 37 people, most from the village's northeast quadrant, attended last Tuesday's meeting, said Mayor Mery Smith.

Smith made the announcement at Monday's village board meeting.

Organizers had hoped that the meeting, held at the high school, would draw at least 50 residents.

While Smith said it is up to residents to get the program up and running, trustee Sherry Ray said she suggested the program be presented again, this time to the Rossville Historical Society.

The Neighborhood Watch presentation, given

by deputy Rick Barnes of the Vermilion County-Sheriff's Department, was videotaped and can be given to smaller groups. Smith said.

In other business, trustees approved changes to water/sewer and gas ordinances.

The changes approved Monday night include increases in several fees, including: gas line meter connection from \$500 to \$700; meter testing from \$10 to \$25; and solictor's license, from \$50/day and \$100/year to \$50/day and \$150 semi-annually.

The board also approved increasing the penalty for those illegally connected to the village sanitary sewer system. The fine, \$200, will remain the same but the village will assess a \$50 per day charge for every day the problem is not corrected.




