

# City waives bid process, will purchase two new trucks

Employees of the city water/sewer department could be in new vehicles by early next week.

The Hoopeston city council voted Tuesday night to waive the bidding process and purchase two 1994 Ford Ranger trucks from the Illinois State Bidding Pool.

The trucks, costing \$7,900 each, are expected to be picked up Friday, said alderman John Haughce, chairman of the water/sewer committee.

This was the second meeting at which Haughee requested the bidding process be waived. The request was made at the Aug. 2 meeting, but some aldermen said local car dealers should be given the chance to bid on the trucks.

At Tuesday's meeting. Haughee said he spoke with two of the three Hoopeston dealers who told

him it would be in the best interests of the city to accept the state prices. "They felt, really, there would be no need to bid." Haughce said. "I feel sure they were of the opinion that...this was the right thing to do."

Alderman Bill Goodwine, who voiced objections at the earlier meeting, said "a lot of my objections are satisfied" since Haughee contacted dealers, but added "I feel bidding is kind of sacred."

The truck purchase was approved unanimously. In other action, the council:

• discussed out-of-town residents abusing the city's dumping slab on Route 1.

heard the Jaycees installed a new heating/air conditioning unit at the civic center.

• learned the pool will close Aug. 21.
