Miss Oklahoma named new National Sweetheart

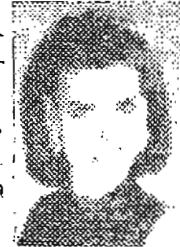
Heather Rae Geery of Edmund, Ok., will reign as the 1994 National Sweetheart.

Geery was crowned Sunday night at the Sweetheart Pageant, part of the National Sweetheart Festival.

Contestants are runners up in state pageants. Since 1980, four National Sweethearts have gone on to win the Miss America title. This year's Miss America pageant boasts six candidates who participated in previous National Sweetheart competition.

Geery was chosen one of 10 finalists after preliminary competition among 25 contestants Friday and Saturday.

Miss Virginia, Kimberly Lynn Welch, was named first runner up, followed by Miss Hawaii, Traci Toguchi, Miss Utah, Nanette Rachelle Pearson, and Miss Massachusetts, Sunita Paramsothy.

The title of Miss Congeniality went to Tracie Jeanne Guenette, Miss Rhode Island. It was her second consecutive Miss Congeniality title at the pageant.
