## City officials to apply for housing rehabilitation grants

Thirty homeowners in Hoopeston may get help with housing repairs if the state approves a planned grant application.

The Hoopeston city council on Tuesday approved applying for \$441,000 in housing rehabilitation grants to help residents of the city's northeast side.

Two applications will be filed, said Scott Rose, housing program manager for the Champaign County Regional Planning Commission.

Rose is working as a consultant to the city on the project.

The first application will request approximately \$331,000 from the state Community Development Assistance Program, Rose said. The second will ask for \$110,000 in Illinois Housing Development Authority trust funds.

Both applications will be made next month, Rose said. Grant recipients are expected to be announced in January.

If Hoopeston receives the grants, residents of the

northeast side will be asked to apply for funds. Applicants will be screened based on financial need and the condition of their homes, Rose said.

The money will be used to correct health and safety problems in 30 Hoopeston homes. Each home will receive approximately \$13,000 worth of work, Rose said.

If the grants are awarded, construction would not begin until "late next spring or early next summer or when the money becomes available," Rose said.

City officials decided to apply for grants after preliminary surveys showed interest in the program. Rose said 42 area residents returned survey forms distributed in July and August.

Of those, 38 included the names and addresses of homeowners.

Rose said he does not know what the city's chances are for having the applications accepted. "I hope their chances are good," he said. "I think it could be a positive step for the city."

## School bus/truck accident injures two area residents

Three people were injured Wednesday after an early morning accident involving two pick up trucks and a Hoopeston Area school bus.

Injured were Darren M. Lucas, 31, of Hoopeston, driver of one of the vehicles, and Mrs. John G. French, no age given, of rural Rankin, a passenger in a truck driven by her husband.

Both were taken to Hoopeston Community Memorial Hospital where Lucas was treated for scrapes and French was treated for a possible broken arm, police said.

The accident occurred at 7:30 a.m. five miles west of Hoopeston on Route 9.

The school bus, driven by Raymond R. Sinclair of Hoopeston, was stopped behind another bus. The French vehicle was stopped behind Sinclair's bus. According to police, Lucas did not realize traffic was stopped and struck the French vehicle, pushing it into the bus.

Lucas was ticketed for failure to reduce speed to avoid an accident.

None of the 58 students on the bus was injured.

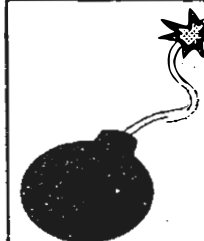
