Marching Cornjerkers in Viking Invitational

The Hoopeston Area Cornjerkers will travel to Danville Saturday to participate in the 21st annual Viking Invitational Marching Band Contest.

The competition is hosted by the Danville "Band of Vikings."

Hoopeston Area, rated in Class AA, will compete against Newton and Champaign Centennial high schools.

Other participating schools include Watseka, Westville and Georgetown-Ridge Farm in class B and Bradley Bourbonnais, Paxton-Buckley Loda and Monticello. Class A.

Clinton and Danville high schools will present exhibition performances.

The event begins at 10 a.m. with a parade starting at the corner of Williams and Vermilion. The parade route heads south on Vermilion to North Street, then east to Jackson and north to Danville High School, 715 N. Jackson.

Field competition will begin at 1 p.m. at Danville High School, followed by an awards ceremony at 4:15 p.m.

Admission to the field show is \$3 for adults, \$2 for students and \$10 for a family pass.

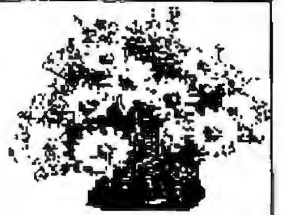
