Council names new street, alley superintendent

Hoopeston's streets and alleys will be looked after by a new superintendent, beginning later this month

Dave Knake, 51, of Hoopeston, was named new street and alley superintendent at Tucsday's Hoopeston city council meeting.

Knake comes to the city from the Vermilion County Housing Authority where he has served as modernization coordinator for the past three years.

As modernization coordinator, Knake was responsible for overseeing all remodeling done on low-income housing.

Prior to is tenure there. Knake operated his own construction business, but gave it up for the security of working for someone else. "Winters can be pretty tough when there's no work," he said.

Knake plans to start his new position later this month. His last day with the housing authority is

Oct. 14.

While there is little similarity between housing and streets and alleys, Knake said the differences will not prove a problem for him. "The supervision of things and people will be the same, but it will be a little more hands on instead of watching somebody else do it." he said.

Although he was happy with the work he currently does. Knake said the new position is an advancement, one that he is looking forward to.

"It's my own town, so hopefully, the people will benefit from it," he said. "Hoopeston's been good to me. I hope I can give back as much as they've given me."

Knake is engaged to Katherine Anderson. The couple plan a summer wedding. He is the father of two daughters, Shelly Dennis of Hoopeston and Deborah Kiogma of Alanson. Mich. He also has three grandchildren.

Rossville, Hoopeston fire departments battle blazes

Members of the Hoopeston fire departments had a hot time Tuesday, battling first a house fire, and later, a burning barn.

The department was first called at 3:09 p.m. to a house fire at 3800 North Road and 1650 East Road.

Although the house, owned by Charles Gernand and rented by Bobby Lee, is in the Rossville district. Hoopeston firefighters were called first, said Wendell Davan, Rossville fire chief.

Davan said the fire probably started in the kitchen, resulting from an electrical short. The kitchen and bathroom were burned in the blaze.

while the rest of the house suffered smoke damage. Davan said.

No dollar estimate of damage has been established, Davan said. No one was home at the time of the fire.

The Hoopeston department was then called at 6:57 p.m. to a barn fire 1.5 miles south of Hoopeston on the hospital road.

The barn, located at the Soliday residence, contained horses, but whether any were injured was not known at press time.

Also unknown were the cause of the fire and damage estimate.
