## Alderman Wes Dazey dies, services scheduled Friday

Long-time Hoopeston alderman Wesley E. Dazey, 70, died at 3:25 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 25, 1994, at United Samaritans Medical Center, Logan campus, Danville.

Funeral services will be 2 p.m. Friday, Oct. 28 at the First Christian Church. Burial will be in Floral Hill Cemetery. Visitation will be 6-8 p.m. Thursday at the Brown-Alkire Funeral Home.

Memorial contributions are suggested to the First Christian Church of Hoopeston.

Mr. Dazey was born July 1, 1924 in Hoopeston. He was employed by Silver Brothers construction company for 23 years, then served eight years as custodian for Hoopeston schools, retiring in 1989. He operated Wes's Sharp Shop for many years.

Mr. Dazey was a member and deacon of the First Christian Church; served in the U.S. Navy during WW II; and was a former chief of the Hoopeston Fire Department, retiring in April

Ault said a new first ward alderman will be selected in the future, but "that hasn't even crossed my mind yet."

Mr. Dazey is survived by his wife, Ruth; three children; and one grandchild.




