## City implements new application for building permit

Residents requiring a building permit in Hoopeston now have a new way to do so.

City officials recently began using a new form, which will make the process easier, said Mayor Bob Ault.

The form, an application for building permit, requests 15 pieces of information, including the name of the property owner, address, phone, best time to be contacted, new construction, contractor's name, intended use, size and type of construction and roof type of the building, estimated cost of construction, zoning in the area of construction, parcel identification and whether plans are available for view.

Once the form has been completed, it is forwarded to building inspector Harry Johnson, Ault said.

## Hoopeston Community Bank assets top \$50 million mark

The new form was implemented to "make it more convenient for people requiring a building permit and to become more professional," Ault said. "I think this is where it needs to be."

Although there is no backlog of building permit requests, Ault said it is sometimes difficult to reach Johnson, who is a part time inspector. "Sometimes it's kind of hard to run him down," he said.

Each of the questions is designed to help streamline the process of getting a permit, Ault said. For example, the estimated cost of construction helps determine the cost of the permit.

The new applications for building permits are now in use and available at city hall from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

So far, only one application has been filed, Ault said.

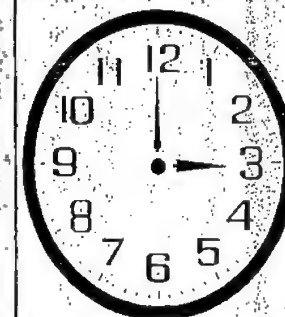
