

### Landfill owners gear up for new round of hearings

Owners of the Illinois Landfills, Inc. site in Hoopeston are preparing themselves to go to court once again.

Company spokesman Jim Van Weelden said "it wasn't a total surprise" that expansion opponents appealed for rehearing with the Fourth Appellate Court in Springfield.

The court decided last month to remand the decision on whether the landfill should be granted a 120-acre expansion back to the city council.

Expansion opponents last week filed an appeal asking the court to rehear the issue.

"We will wait for the decision of the court," Van Weelden said, adding the company will be prepared if the appeal is unsuccessful and opponents file for a hearing with the state Supreme Court, a

move under consideration.

Meanwhile, it will be business as usual at the landfill. "We've done everything in good faith," he said. "We've gone this far, we'll go ahead with our siting."

Van Weelden did not comment on a petition drive to have an advisory referendum concerning the expansion placed on the April 3 ballot.

Opponents have mounted a drive to get the issue on the ballot to determine how a majority of Hoopeston residents feel about the expansion.

Nor would he comment on efforts to unseat incumbent aldermen with anti-expansion candidates. "I think for me to comment on somebody's political aspirations would be inappropriate," he said.

### Police seek suspect in rash of weekend car vandalism

Hoopeston police believe they have a suspect in nine cases of auto burglary and criminal damage to auto reported Sunday.

At least one arrest in the case should be made this week, said Sgt. Steve Bane.

Bane said more than one person was probably involved in the damage, which included broken rearview mirrors, ripped headliners and broken ash trays. One car had cereal poured over the interior.

A vehicle reported stolen may also be linked to the reports of damage, Bane said. "(Vandals) went down a line of cars at Honeywell Apartments and they found one with the keys in it," he said.

To prevent future cases of damage, Bane sug-

gested owners remove keys from vehicles, lock doors and keep copies of serial numbers of all electronic equipment, such as portable compact disc players.

The board of directors will participate Wednesday in the fourth annual retreat and planning session, said Dick McMurray, 1995 Chamber presi-


