Potomac man to open third funeral home in city

After trying for three years, a Potomac man will finally have a funeral home in Hoopeston.

Don Wolfe plans to open Hoopeston's third funral home at 907 W. Main.

The building had been a residence, Wolfe said, but is located in an area zoned for commercial development.

Wolfe tried to open a funeral home in Hoopeston three years ago, when he purchased a house at 518 E. Penn.

However, after he purchased the property at auction. Wolfe learned it was not zoned for business, even though the former owner had operated one there.

Wolfe appeared before the Hoopeston planning commission twice hoping to get a variance on the

The first time, neighbors said opening a funeral home would degrade their property, he said. The second time, "other funeral home directors got involved."

Both times, the change was denied.

Wolfe then began looking for property already zoned commercial. He purchased a lot on Route 9, but sold it when he was approached by Ter-

Wolfe's most recent purchase has already been gutted and is being remodeled.

The new funeral home is approximately 2,000 square feet and will feature a "huge visitation room" that can be divided, allowing two visitations to be held simultaneously. The new business will be a "full-service funeral home," complete with "the latest, state-of-the-art" embalming room. Wolfe said.

The building will be "100 percent handicapped accessible," and will offer parking for 40-50 cars on an adjoining lot, he said.

Wolfe said a third funeral home is needed in Hoopeston to handle the approximately 110 funerals per year "in and around Hoopeston. I keep See FUNERAL on other side


