

Dignitaries to attend Masonic rededication rite

Dignitaries from Freemasonry throughout Illinois are expected to gather in Hoopeston Sunday for the rededication of the local Masonic temple.

The rededication ceremony is scheduled for 3 p.m. Sunday at the lodge, 206 W. Orange. The ceremony, along with the open house scheduled from 4-5 p.m., are open to the public, according to Worshipful Master Steve Eyrich.

The Grand Master of Illinois, along with masters from lodges throughout the state, are expected to attend.

The ceremony marks the completion of repairs done to the building following a November 1993 fire.

The blaze, listed as an electrical fire of undetermined origin, caused approximately \$150,000 damage, Eyrich said.

Roughly one-third of the building was de-

stroyed, including hand-crafted chairs and gavel stands. A clock in the meeting room was melted in the blaze and "ran like a crayon on a register," Eyrich said.

Some furniture was salvaged and was refinished and reupholstered by Der Schreiner in Hoopeston. Other pieces were demolished and had to be recreated.

One chair, called the Oriental chair, was reconstructed from photographs at a cost of \$6,500, excluding upholstery, Eyrich said.

The temple had minor cosmetic changes made while being repaired. Some windows were paneled over, Eyrich said, and the hall now has recessed lighting "which is very nice."

While the building was being repaired, the group met at the Eastern Illinois Multi Purpose Center, returning to the temple last October.
