## Heavy turnout predicted for municipal election

A heavy turnout is expected for today's election in Hoopeston.

One reason for the predicted high turnout is the landfill advisory referendum appearing on today's ballot.

The referendum asks whether the city council should grant a 120-acre expansion for the Illinois Landfills, Inc. site in Hoopeston.

Because the referendum is an advisory one, the results are not binding on the council.

A second referendum appears on today's ballot.

asking voters to enlarge the Hoopeston Public Library district from serving Grant Township to including all of the Hoopeston Area and Rossville-Alvin school districts.

If passed, the tax rate for the expanded district will be .17 per \$100 assessed valuation.

Beside referenda, voters will also decide who will sit on local city councils.

## Write-in candidate seeks seat on Hoopeston Library board

A Hoopeston man is a write-in candidate for the Hoopeston Public Library board.

Tony Hasbargen, 27, is the seventh candidate for seven seats on the board.

"I think the library is doing a good job and they offer a lot of services," Hasbargen said. "I would like to be a part of that."

Hasbargen favors the expanded library district, to be voted on in today's election. An expanded district would "allow the people in the district the most up-to-date information possible," he said.

Hasbargen is a 1985 Hoopeston-East Lynn graduate and received an associate's degree from DACC in computer programming. He is employed at UPPCO, Inc., Monticello, Ind., as a purchasing agent.

He and his wife, Lori, have four children. Greg, Todd, Samantha and Alexandra.

Other candidates for the board include Sharilyn (Sherry) Miller, Mark Conolly, Dale Fry, Lawrence Jahn, Janet Crouch and Don Sherrill.




