# Rossville trustees OK donation for training aid

ROSSVILLE—Trustees here are doing their part to make young children aware of the dangers of fire.

The board Monday night approved donating \$500 toward the purchase of a child safety house.

Assistant fire chief Bill Smock requested a donation for the house, a mobile miniature of a real house.

The Illinois and Indiana Mutual Aid group, of which Rossville is a member, hopes to purchase the approximately \$30,000 training aid.

The house, which includes a kitchen, living room and bedroom, is manned by trained instructors who show children ages 3-8 how to prevent and survive fires.

For example, Smock said, the bedroom is filled

with non-toxic smoke so youngsters learn to crawl along the floor, feel doors for heat and use safety ladders.

Ross Township, the Rossville Fire Department and Rossville Fire District have also contributed to the fund.

In other action, trustees voted not to spend \$5,352 with Sodeman & Associates engineers of Champaign, to provide a report on problems at the sewage treatment plant.

"I don't think we should put out any more money for inspection fees," said trustee Charles Cornell, adding a similar report was received free from village engineers Upchurch & Associates.

Mayor Merv Smith said the village's next step


